

Visitor Centre - it houses the Gift Shop, Classroom, Public Restrooms, Admissions Desk, and Administrative Offices

Woodland Trail - With the entrance located directly behind the Visitor Centre, this trail offers an opportunity to view Grand Cayman's woodland interior through a loop pathway that is almost a mile in length.

Orchid Boardwalk - A 600 ft long raised boardwalk over a seasonally flooded woodland provides the perfect habitat to display local and regional orchids. The best time to view the local orchids is from April to June.

Heritage Garden - With a restored Caymanian House as its centre piece, the area showcases how life was at the turn of the century in the Cayman Islands.

Xeriphytic Garden - This new garden exhibits plants from different geographic regions of the world that possess xeriphytic qualities which have a low supplemental water requirement. Here you will find cactus, succulent plants and many more that exhibit these same qualities.

Floral Colour Garden - Designed a series of gardens arranged by colour, this garden presents year long garden through its' meandering path through many shaded areas. Next to the white section you will find the gazebo which provides a shaded seating area overlooking a lily pond.

Palm Walk - this recently developed garden showcases over 60 species of palms and cycads set among the native woodland.

The Lake and Wetland - Situated on the edge of a Buttonwood Swamp, this area provides birdwatchers with a great opportunity to view many of the Cayman Islands native birds as well as many migratory species

Plant Shop - Located at the Nursery we offer a wide range of plants for sale. It is open from 9:00 am to 4:00 seven days a week.

Cayman Blue Iguanas - There are approximately 40 of these highly endangered animals wandering about the park. Only watch and photograph them as they are wild animals. Never attempt to feed them as they will bite! The Blue Iguana Safaris take place Monday through Saturday at 11:00am only. Please purchase tickets at the Visitor Centre Admission Desk prior to the tour.

Restrooms - Are located at the Visitor Centre, in the Floral Colour Garden (Yellow Section) and next to the Nursery.

Friends of the Botanic Park - Members of the Friends enjoy benefits such as; unlimited entry to the Botanic Park, 10% discount in the gift shop, members' only events and more. Please inquire at Gift Shop for more information.

Hours of Operation - The park is open daily at 9:00 am with last admission at 4:30 pm and the park closes at 5:30 pm. We are located approximately 30 minutes drive from George Town, in the District of North Side at 367 Botanic park Road, just off Frank Sound Road. Admission rates are \$8.00 CI for Adults and children ages 12 and under are free when accompanied by an adult. Private Tours may be arranged in advance only and will cost an additional \$8.00 CI. Please remember to stay on pathways and no pets of any kind are allowed in the QEII Botanic Park.
